



Unlimited ebook copies of the eBook are now available to check out through your local library's digital catalog "Library2Go".

Library card holders in Umatilla County have access to Library2Go through the LEO Listens member group. Library2Go eBooks can be read on a computer, eBook reader, or mobile devices such as tablets or smart phones. Contact your library for help with using the digital library collection.

Big Library Read enables users from 10 different countries on five different continents to join in one of the largest global reading events ever to occur. From now until June 1st, users will be able to log in to their digital library website and check out this wonderful tale about love, secrets and the mysterious bonds only families can form.

The Four Corners of the Sky is master storyteller Michael Malone's novel of love, secrets, and the mysterious bonds of families. Malone brings characters to life as only he can, exploring the questions that defy easy answers: Is love a choice or a calling? Why do the ties of family bind so tightly? And is forgiveness a gift to others...or a gift we give ourselves?
